Rationale for Change:	<p>There are several occurrences of the Accept Request Header Field value that are erroneous in the UPS-RS sections of PS3.18, namely "1#-dicom-media-type".</p> <p>Here, "1#" is a prefix according to the ABNF List Rule defined in Section 5.1.3 List Rule('#'). The part that follows, in this case "-dicom-media-type" should be a defined token, but this supposedly should have been "dicom-media-type", as defined in Section 8.7.3.5 Media Type Syntax.</p>
