Log Summary: Fix empty N-CREATE conflict with PPS Discontinuation Reason workflow	
Name of Standard PS3.4	
<p>Rationale for Change:</p> <p>CP-1738 introduced the prohibition of sending empty Type 3 attributes. However, this creates a conflict with existing DICOM requirements for Performed Procedure Step (PPS) workflow.</p> <p>DICOM PS3.4 Section F.7.2, Note 5 states: "Only Attributes that are specified in a SOP Instance at N-CREATE may later be updated through the N-SET. If an SCU wishes to use the PPS Discontinuation Reason Code Sequence (0040,0281), it must create that Attribute (zero-length) during N-CREATE."</p> <p>This creates an impossible scenario:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To later send a discontinuation reason, the modality must create the Performed Procedure Step Discontinuation Reason Code Sequence (0040,0281) as zero-length (empty) during N-CREATE</li> <li>• PS3.4 Section 5.4.2.1 prohibits sending empty Type 3 attributes in N-SET operations</li> <li>• The SCU cannot comply with both requirements - it must send an empty Type 3 attribute in N-CREATE to enable later N-SET updates, but cannot subsequently use N-SET to provide the actual value due to Section 5.4.2.1 restrictions.</li> </ul> <p>This CP resolves the conflict by changing the usage specification for (0040,0281) to require optional creation during N-CREATE and N-SET operations.</p>	
Change Wording:	

**Update PS3.4 Section 5.4.2.1 DIMSE Service N-CREATE, N-SET, N-ACTION, as follows:**

## 5 5.4.2.1 DIMSE Service N-CREATE, N-SET, N-ACTION

The following Requirements apply when specifying the use of DIMSE Services N-CREATE, N-SET, N-ACTION.

The convention used in the table below are as follows:

SCU Behavior

**Mandatory** The SCU shall provide the Attribute.

10 **Optional** The SCU may or may not provide the Attribute.

**Undefined** The SCU's usage of the Attribute is undefined.

SCP Behavior

**Mandatory** The SCP shall support receiving the Attribute.

- 15 **Mandatory with Default**      The SCP shall support receiving the Attribute. Upon receiving zero-length values, the SCP shall assign values as defined by the specification of the Service Class.
- Optional**                              The SCP may or may not support receiving the Attribute.
- Undefined**                              The SCP's support of the Attribute is undefined.

If the SCU does not provide an Attribute that is Mandatory for the SCU, the SCP shall respond with a Failure Status Code of 0120H "Missing Attribute".

If the SCU provides a zero-length value for a Mandatory Attribute when zero length is not permitted, the SCP shall respond with a Failure Status Code of 0121H "Missing Attribute Value".

25 **Only Attributes that are specified as top level attributes in a SOP Instance at N-CREATE may later be updated through the N-SET. For example, the PPS Discontinuation Reason Code Sequence (0040,0281) needs to be present in the N-CREATE request (with a zero-length value) if a discontinuation code might be provided later.**

**A top level Sequence Attribute may be replaced by an N-SET operation. Modification of the contents of the Sequence requires providing the complete new Sequence value.**

1. The requirement for the final state is that which applies at the time that the Performed Procedure Step Status (0040,0252) is N-SET to a value of COMPLETED or DISCONTINUED, as described in Section F.7.2.2.2. It is only described if it is different from the SCP requirement for the N-CREATE.
2. The Performed Series Sequence (0040,0340) may not be empty (zero length) at the time that the Performed Procedure Step Status (0040,0252) is N-SET to a value of COMPLETED or DISCONTINUED. In other words a Series must exist for every Performed Procedure Step, though it may contain no Images or Non-Image Composite objects, if none were created, as described in Section F.7.2.2.2.

3. Attributes (0040,1006) Placer Order Number/Procedure and (0040,1007) Filler Order Number/Procedure were previously defined in DICOM. They are now retired (see PS3.3-1998).
  4. Attributes (0040,2006) and (0040,2007) were previously defined in DICOM. They are now retired (see PS3.3-1998).
  5. ~~Only Attributes that are specified in a SOP Instance at N-CREATE may later be updated through the N-SET. If an SCU wishes to use the PPS Discontinuation Reason Code Sequence (0040,0284), it must create that Attribute (zero-length) during N-CREATE.~~
